NOTICE OF RACE

Fleet 95 Scituate, MA

October 4-5

Fleet 95 is the Organizing Authority for this regatta. Satuit Boat Club is hosting and race management support in part provided by Scituate Harbor Yacht Club.

Conditions

1. Rules - This regatta shall be governed by the Rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2001-2004 (RRS). The regatta is subject to the advertising restrictions as defined in RRS Appendix 1 (Advertising). Those entries satisfying Appendix 1 for Category C are urged to refrain from displaying advertisements for business or products competing with those of the primary and support sponsors of the event.

2. Personal Flotation - Personal flotation shall be worn as required by class rules. Competitors should be aware that the race committee may display Flag "Y" in accordance with RRS 40.

3. Eligibility –

3.1 This regatta is open to all current members of the J/24 class. Only current members of District 1 shall be eligible for the District 1 Championship title (including 2nd, 3rd, 4th, & 5th place awards) and the 2004 J/24 World's qualifying berth.

3.2 Easily removable bow stickers shall be attached to the forward 25% of both sides of the boat's hull at all times while racing. The stickers are to be carried with the top approximately 6"-10" below deck level and with the leading edge approximately 10"-20" aft of the bow. Bow stickers will be provided in the Skipper's package.

4. Entries - Entries shall meet eligibility requirements no later than September 26. Completed entry forms, with entry fee, shall be mailed to: Fleet 95, c/o CapeCode, Inc., 189 Front Street, Suite One, Scituate, MA 02066 and must be accepted by the Organizing Authority. Late entries may be accepted solely at the discretion of Organizing Authority.

Fees: Entry - \$60.00

5. Registration - Each boat owner or his representative must report to the Satuit Boat Club between 4:30 pm and 7:30 pm Friday, October 3 or between 8:00 am and 9:30 am Saturday to complete registration details.

Crew lists and waivers of liability must be submitted at registration. No boat will be registered without a completed waiver form. In the event of a crew member substitution during the regatta, the new crew member must submit a signed waiver of liability to the Race Committee prior to racing for that boat's entry to be valid.

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration. Amendments to the Sailing Instructions will be posted at the Satuit Boat Club by 9:00 am daily. It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the Official Notice Board for any amendments or other notices.

6. Courses - Courses will be sailed off-shore from Scituate Harbor. Course patterns will be provided with the Sailing Instructions.

7. Schedule of Races – It is the intent of the Organizing Authority and the Race Committee to run as many races as practical on each race day up to a maximum of six (6) races for the series. First gun will be at 11:00 am on Saturday, 10:00 am Sunday.

8. Measurement and Weigh-in - Each boat shall submit proof of holding a valid certificate at registration. Weigh-ins shall take place concurrently with registration.

9. Scoring - The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A will apply. Each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. Three races will constitute a series. No races previously sailed will count toward the District One Championship.

10. Prizes - Prizes will be awarded Sunday, October 5, at the conclusion of racing.

11. Berthing - Moorage/slips and dock space for the regatta will be arranged upon registration.

12. Photographers and TV Rights - Competitors give absolute right and permission for any photographs or video footage taken of themselves or their competing boat to be published in any media whatsoever; for either editorial or advertising purposes, or to be used in press information.

13. General information - Additional information regarding directions, updates, launching, etc... will be available on www.capecode.net/fleet95.

14. Payment by Credit Card – Electronic registration will be available at www.layline.com for those competitors who wish to pay by credit card.
